STORY OF CHANGE



Rita Devi, 27 years is from Bhadarkali village, in Himachal Pradesh. Many women like Rita have never visited a gynecologist and babies are usually delivered at home with the help of mid-wives. Her Hb level was low at 9 counts when she enrolled in the health project. She now goes for regular antenatal check ups at the community sub centre.

“I had my first baby at home because my husband did not allow me to go to the hospital. But now the doctor has given me the confidence. I will deliver in the government hospital. My family will be complete after the baby arrives.” Rita Devi

iPartner India seeks to leverage the power of giving towards creating a more **just and equitable society**. We focus on helping major **donors and businesses** discover, engage with, and support inspiring projects in India to help bring about change.

OUR IMPACT IN 2015

We supported the care and protection of 225 street and abandoned children in Delhi. We support a shelter home and a day care centre, where 40-50 children benefit from nutritious meals and education. Children also learn and improve from the psychosocial counselling and recreational activities at the centre.

12 girls from very poor families in Mangalore are attending higher education through our scholarship programme. Many of them never imagined attending higher education, and are first generation college goers from their families. They are now role models for their siblings and peers.

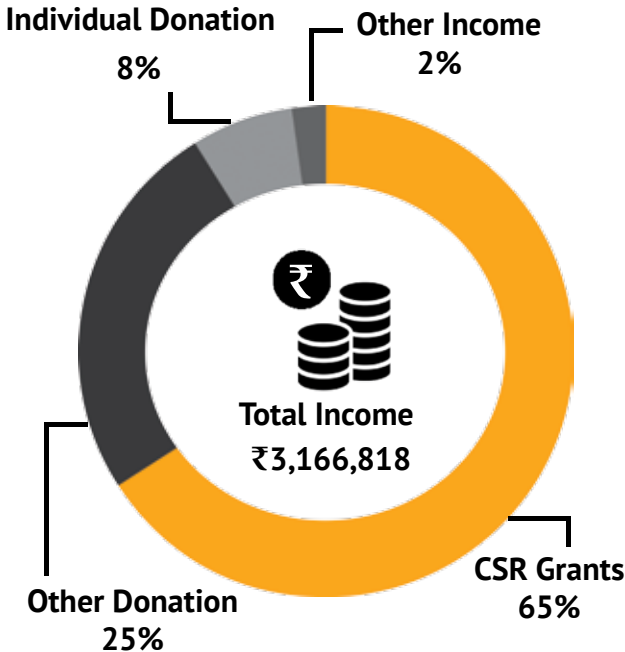

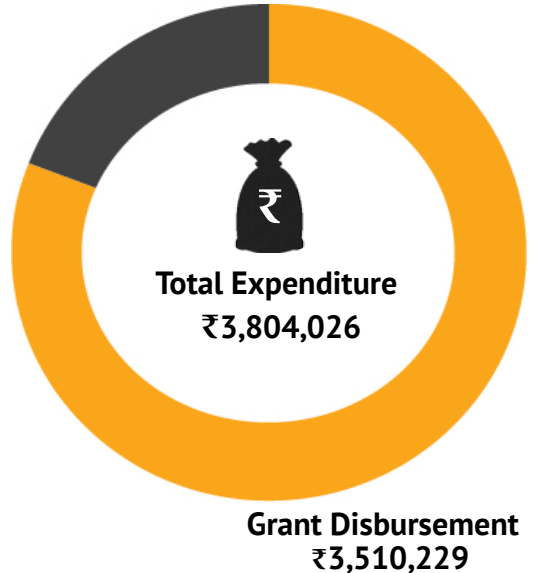
In our mission to support sustainable livelihoods, we supported the training of 70 young men and women in solar technician trade, in Jaipur, Rajasthan. Trained youth have got employment in Rajasthan government enterprises and in the hotel industry. Some have become micro solar entrepreneurs.

Preventable diseases such as diabetes and anemia are highly prevalent in rural areas of Una district in Himachal Pradesh. In the healthcare project supported by iPartner India 11,392 people benefitted from regular health camps. School health camps focussed on dental hygiene, anemia, drugs and alcoholism amongst children and young adolescents.
