# SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES AND SCHEDULES FORMING PART OF ACCOUNTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED ON 31<sup>ST</sup> MARCH, 2022 FOREIGN CONTRIBUTIONS ACCOUNT

#### A. SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

- The financial statements of the Trust have been prepared under the historical cost convention on the accrual basis of accounting (except otherwise stated) in accordance with the applicable accounting standards issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India and the Generally Accepted Accounting Principles (GAAP) in India.
- Grants/Donations are accounted for on receipt basis.
- 3. Fixed Assets acquired are directly charged to expenses account and stated in the Balance Sheet through Fixed Assets Fund Account. However to present a more realistic picture of value of assets appearing in the Balance Sheet, depreciation at the rates provided in the Income Tax Rule, 1962 is being reduced from the cost of fixed assets on the written down value method. Written down value of assets so arrived at is shown as both the assets & liability side of Balance Sheet.

#### B. NOTES TO ACCOUNTS

- The Trust has obtained regular registration under Foreign Contribution (Regulation) Act 2010 (FCRA) during the year 2017-18 and has further filed for renewal and permission awaited.
- The reporting under FCRA has been done on Receipts and Payment Basis, however, the Trust has also compiled and attached Income & Expenditure Account as per the requirement of Foreign Contribution (Regulation) Rules, 2011.
- a. The Trust has sold Computer of Rs.25,490 having WDV of Rs.5,506 respectively at Rs.6,400. The necessary adjustment entries have been passed in Fixed Assets and Fixed Assets Fund.
  - b. The trust has acquired Computers of Rs.60,024 and Office Equipment's of Rs. 23,800 during the year
- The administrative expenses are within 20% of the receipts during the financial year.





- Trust has utilized the whole amount of Rakshan Project & Livelihood Fund Rs. 12,04,138 in the current financial year.
- Previous year figures have been regrouped and reclassified wherever considered necessary.
